Worksheet Module 1 Week 1: Map sanitation and waste management challenges in your locality

- Draw a map of your area including water sources; distribution and collection systems; domestic, industrial and agricultural water users and waste producers; treatment plants and other landmarks relevant for visualising the water, energy and nutrient flows in your area. You may use the templates from the publication "SDG 6 along the Water and Nutrient Cycles" on the following pages to design your locality map.
- 2. Then you note the sanitation and waste management challenges where they arise. You might also want to highlight any hot spots, so areas where the challenges are concentrated.
- 3. Also indicate who is responsible for these challenges: so who is responsible for the waste in the streets and who is responsible for the faecal sludge being dumped into the river.
- 4. As a last step, think about if and how these challenges are connected with each other.
- 5. To get started, just take a big piece of paper, print and cut out the puzzle pieces from the following pages, grab some colour pens and get creative.
